

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-02

ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE JUNE LAKE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-01

The Board of Directors of the June Lake Public Utility District finds that:

- 1) District Ordinance No. 2008-01 established a water management program for the June Lake Public Utility District, and
- 2) The Board of Directors of the District has determined it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 2008-01 for water management and conservation purposes.

Be it enacted by the Board of Directors of the June Lake Public Utility District:

- 1) The Stage 3 Water Emergency restriction in Ordinance No. 2008-01 states:

“STAGE 3 – WATER EMERGENCY. During a Stage 3 – Water shortage emergency, Stages 1 and 2 restrictions applies and also the following shall apply:
1) The use of water for other than domestic and commercial use is prohibited.”

The Stage 3 restrictions in Ordinance No. 2008-01 are amended to state:

STAGE 3 – WATER EMERGENCY. During a Stage 3 water shortage emergency, the restrictions under Stage 1, parts (1)–(5), and Stage 2, parts (2)–(5), apply and also the following shall apply: 1) Outdoor watering shall be limited to no more than two days per week. Odd-numbered addresses are limited to watering on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Even-numbered addresses are limited to watering on Mondays and Wednesdays. No irrigation shall take place on Fridays, Saturdays or Sundays.

- 2) The Enforcement section of Ordinance No. 2008-01 is amended to add the following provision:

Appeal. Any person may appeal the imposition of a fine imposed pursuant to this Ordinance by following the following administrative procedures: The appellant shall submit a written appeal to the General Manager within 15 calendar days from receiving notification of a fine. The District shall provide a response within 30 days of receipt of the appeal. If an appeal is denied, the appellant may submit the appeal request for review by the Board of Directors. The Board’s decision shall be final. If the Board denies the appeal, the appellant shall pay any disputed fine(s).

Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption.
